It was no secret to the Millbrook community that Coole Park Farm had been on the market for some time, with many wondering what would become of one of the quintessential equestrian properties in the Millbrook Hunt Country. A key equestrian venue to the Millbrook community, including the long-standing Millbrook Horse Trials, and host to many of the Millbrook Hunt's opening meets and famous breakfasts, Coole Park Farm's property is deeply rooted in Millbrook's equestrian tradition.

It was just this past winter that Coole Park found itself changing hands from David and Connie Clapp, who had previously owned the farm, to new owner Riga Meadow Property, another long-standing equestrian operation, which had previously been based just over the Connecticut border in Salisbury.

Catching up with Linda, the head trainer who has been operating the business of Riga Meadow for the

past 15 years, we learned more about the move to the new digs, her operation, and her plans.

It was a quick change in circumstances for Linda and her Riga business, as the plan was not originally anticipated, but, in the back end of 2018, she was in a position where she very quickly had to find a new home for her operation, which was not small. Finding a farm that had the capacity to ac-

commodate her own six horses and countless dedicated clients, put her in a situation where she had to think quickly, and, thanks to the kindness and dedication of ten long-standing Riga Meadow supporters, they were able to quickly put the funds together to purchase Coole Park Farm at the New Year, and move in by February. This allowed Linda the opportunity to continue to run her lovely Riga Meadow business.

Since February, Linda has focused most of her time on settling into the new property and adjusting to Coole Park Farm. It is a big change from her previous farm; after having been based out of the same farm for 15 years, it took time to learn the ins and outs, as well as new routines,

of her new venue. She plans on taking some time in the first year to get her clients, horses and business settled and into a routine before delving into other activities.

Linda commented on how welcoming the Mill-brook community has been, from other equestrian farms to the local farmers and her neighbors, "everyone has been kind and welcoming, and you can tell how special Coole Park is to the area, so we really want to keep it that way, while incorporating Riga Meadow into the framework of Coole Park." This has made the move much easier, and Linda is looking forward to working with everyone and becoming part of the weave in the tight-knit Millbrook equestrian community. She knows that local riders have loved all the schooling shows previously held at Coole Park, and would like to be able to offer some in the future. She also hopes that she is able to resurrect the USEA-sanctioned Riga Meadow events in the coming

seasons, as she knows how popular and critical the Riga Meadow events are to the Area I eventing community.

Riga Meadow is looking forward to welcoming the Millbrook Horse Trials this year, and having some of the best American riders *literally* in their backyard, alongside the back-bone riders of our sport and our amateur and young riders. Some of her students have competed in the trials in the

past and hope to do so in the future as well. Her operation is based on the ethos of being a farm that is open to all riders, of any level, whether their goal is just to occasionally hack and enjoy their horse or to compete, they are able to do so in a warm, inviting and fun environment.

Anyone is welcome to stop by and say hello. Riga Meadow has six school horses available for lessons, and boarding of all levels and disciplines. Linda and her team look forward to meeting you!



Welcome to our Spectators

We hope that everyone will have a good time at the Millbrook Horse Trials. No other sport permits the spectator such an active role, but one person in the wrong place can ruin months and years of hard work for competitors, as well as place all parties in jeopardy of physical injury. To ensure your safety and that of the competitors, and to preserve the fairness of the competition, please familiarize yourself with the guidelines:

HORSES HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. The horses and riders will be moving at speed across country. Always look both ways before moving and stay alert for warnings from officials. Stay behind marked barriers and ropes and keep clear of the area around each cross-country fence. Please observe the advice or directions of fence judges on the cross-country course.



CHILDREN MUST BE WITH AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES. Children often do not realize the danger that horses present.

DOGS MUST BE LEASHED. Absolutely no exceptions! Loose dogs are a hazard to competing horses and will be impounded and the owners fined \$50. Noisy or disruptive dogs must be removed from the grounds.

AVOID UNAUTHORIZED ASSISTANCE TO COMPETITORS. Providing assistance to a rider during competition, whether solicited or not, is forbidden, under penalty of the competitor's elimination. The only exception to the no assistance rule is in the case of a fall. Officials or spectators may catch a loose horse or aid a fallen rider to remount and adjust saddlery. No one, however, may mount the horse except the rider.

QUIET, PLEASE! Undue noises can cause distractions to horses and riders and can affect the outcome of the competition or cause an accident. Please hold your applause until after a competitor exits the dressage arena, completes a cross-country fence, or finishes the stadium course.

Please be considerate of the site and use trash receptacles. Portions of the competition adjoin private property. We hope you will respect the land and privacy of these generous neighbors.

While observing these precautions, please feel free to move about the competition area in order to see as much as possible of the varied activities. Do not hesitate to ask questions of volunteers and officials, who will be happy to assist you.



The Three Horse Trials Disciplines

Millbrook Horse Trials is conducted under the auspices of the United States Eventing Association (USEA) and the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). In a Horse Trials, the rider and horse, competing at the division level appropriate to their experience, must participate in three different phases: Dressage, Cross Country, and Stadium Jumping. Penalty points from each of these phases are totaled for a final standing. The lowest score wins the division.

DRESSAGE

The dressage test is a series of compulsory movements performed on the flat in an arena. The performance must be fluid, balanced, and accurate, presenting an overall picture of grace and harmony. It reflects the cavalry officer's need for an obedient, attractive mount on the parade ground. Getting a calm, submissive, and well-balanced test from an extremely fit and eager horse before its strenuous gallop cross country is a real achievement.

Each movement of the dressage test is awarded from 0-10 good marks. The good marks earned (minus any error of course or test) are converted into a percentage of the maximum marks available. This percentage is subtracted from 100 to create the penalty score for the test. The resulting total is the score in penalty points for the test.

CROSS COUNTRY


In this phase, considered the most demanding and exciting part of a Horse Trials, the horse and rider must gallop over natural terrain, negotiating at speed a variety of unfamiliar jumping obstacles. The horse does not know what is ahead, but must trust and unhesitatingly obey the rider, who has studied the course beforehand. Water, banks, ditches, drops and other features of natural terrain may be encountered, as well as man-made obstructions. Options of height and striding (distance between jumping efforts) further challenge the competitor's skill and control.

Cross Country proves the speed, endurance and jumping ability of the horse as well as the boldness and knowledge of the rider. It is the most important part of the entire competition and counts most in scoring. Time penalties are assessed, as well as penalties for refusals and falls at jumps and deviations from course.

STADIUM JUMPING

Stadium Jumping tests the horse's obedience and athleticism over a timed course of fixtures which can be easily knocked down by a careless horse. The track of the course is irregular and winding, requiring control and handiness. Penalty points are assessed for knockdowns, refusals, falls, deviations from course, or for exceeding the time allowed. The object of the Stadium Jumping test is to prove that, after jumping solid obstacles at speed in the Cross Country, horses maintain the obedience to jump a course of obstacles cleanly at a controlled pace.

At the end of the Stadium Jumping, each completing competitor's scores from Dressage, Cross Country, and Stadium are totaled. The horse and rider team with the lowest number of penalties is declared the winner. The pageantry of the final ceremonies with trophies and awards is only a small part of the competitor's experience. The true rewards lie in the competition itself. Preparing for, meeting, and mastering the widely varied demands of combined training allow riders to discover what they and their mounts can do. Those who have completed the event can rightly pride themselves on their accomplishments.
