Welcome to the beautiful open landscapes of Millbrook and to the 2023 Millbrook Horse Trials! We are thrilled to be back and up and running again this year!

We are extremely grateful for the outpouring of support that we have received for the Horse Trials since announcing their return, and thank all our friends, neighbors, patrons, volunteers, competitors and spectators for joining together to help us make this happen. Without all of you, the show truly would not go on!

Much has happened since MHT last ran in 2021, and we are happy to share a few updates. In December of last year our longtime Board Chair, Simon Roosevelt, stepped down, as he is moving out of the area to focus on other pursuits. We are all very sad to see him go and thank him profoundly for his many years of wise leadership. It has taken two of us to fill his shoes! We are enthusiastic to take on the challenge of reviving the Event after a short hiatus.

The Millbrook Horse Trials is the largest remaining horse trials in Area I and the only one which runs all 6 levels of eventing, including Advanced. It is a prestigious competition which showcases the best of the sport, attracting top-level riders, including many Olympians, who compete alongside local amateurs. This weekend, you will be likely to see a number of riders who will represent the US in the Paris Olympics next year.

In 2021 we added tailgating and expanded our traditional trade fair to include a selection of local vendors, as well as food trucks and family activities, including a petting zoo and an arts and crafts tent. We hope you will enjoy the excellent shopping, as well as delicious food from our food trucks and our new concession tent, Simply Gourmet.

Our course designer, Morgan Rowsell, graciously stepped in prior to the 2021 Horse Trials, when our longtime designer, Tremaine Cooper, tragically passed away. Morgan's first course was very well received. This year, thanks to additional land graciously lent by our neighbor, Duhallow, Morgan has created new jumps and tracks at all levels, including both a table and a corner with frangible technology at both the Intermediate and Advanced levels, thereby enhancing the safety of horse and rider. 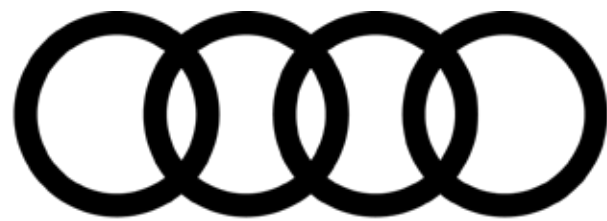

MEET THE EVENTERS BEHIND THE MHT

Is it any surprise that the people responsible for organizing the Millbrook Horse Trials (MHT) are eventers themselves? Probably not, because the personality profile of an eventer is all about grit, determination, creative problem-solving, and dedication to the sport, all with a big dose of joy. We thought it would be fun to share a little about the horse lives of the ‘A’ team behind the MHT.

LOUISE MERYMAN: Eventer. Louise was introduced to the sport of eventing while in college and within four years was competing at the advanced level. She has dedicated her life to the sport ever since. She competed in Germany, Ireland, and Holland before spending a month in 1993 training with Capt. Mark Philips, and riding Downton Uproar for the U.S. at Burghley. She and Olivia van Melle Kamp started the Millbrook Horse trials in 1985, and Louise created the American Horse Trials Foundation in 1987. All of this from a little girl who grew up in Maryland, in a “non-horsey” family. She was eight when her mother arranged for her to get an unbroke Icelandic pony. The deal was she would back and train it for two years and then it would be returned. Of course, when the time was up Louise had to have her own horse. Pat was a half Thoroughbred, ¼ Morgan, and ¼ Icelandic dun with a dorsal stripe. Imagine what that looked like! Pat became Louise’s first true equine partner.

OLIVIA VAN MELLE KAMP: Eventer. Foxhunter. Olivia discovered eventing in the late 50s. She was twelve, and remembers thinking, “it was the ultimate challenge.” Her eventing life kicked into high gear when she was in her 30s and met Louise Meryman, who became her trainer, and encouraged her to compete. “You can’t tell what you’ve learned until you compete,” Meryman told her. Olivia and Louise were part of the group that got together and bought the Kinney dairy farm, the land that the Millbrook Horse Trials takes place on. They started the MHT in 1985. Olivia started foxhunting when the warmblood she was competing was too slow in steeplechase (then a part of the horse trials competition). They thought he could learn to gallop faster following a pack of hounds. (It worked.) When her married life took her away to South Africa and France for twelve years, she still managed to compete and foxhunt along the way; then got right back into the Millbrook Horse Trials groove when she returned.

CAROLINE MERISON: Eventer. Foxhunter. Caroline grew up in a military family moving all around Europe, so owning a pony or joining a real riding program was never an option, even though she rode every chance she got. As soon as she moved to the Millbrook area, she began riding regularly at Tatra Farm. Caroline also foxhunts but it is eventing she's most passionate about. Maybe because her two daughters, Charlie and Lexi, also took up riding, and started their eventing careers. For years, Caroline drove her girls and assorted friends up and down the East Coast to train and compete. They all competed up to prelim level/ 2-star. Caroline has her own barn in Pine Plains where Darrah Alexander, an elite rider, is the resident trainer. Caroline enjoys competing her young Irish warmblood, Nacho, and watching Darrah bring on a gifted group of amateur riders, including Cassie Sanger, who will be competing this weekend. Caroline will be too busy with her MHT duties to compete but keep an eye out for Darrah on Nacho in the preliminary division.

MIMI BABCOCK: Eventer. Foxhunter. Carriage Driver. Hunter/Jumper. Trainer. Mimi has ridden all her life. As a teenager, and through her college years, she competed in competitive carriage driving with ponies. Then her mother-in-law had driving horses, and she spent a lot of time with them (see photo below). She has competed in hunters and jumpers. She's trained young horses and taken OTTBs and restarted them. She loves foxhunting, which she did for years. All this while raising a family and working a day job. But it is eventing that she's really dedicated herself to. She started training with Louise Meryman in the 90s. Then took her horse, Groovy Girl, through training level with the guidance of trainer Kerry Milliken. "She was so influential in my riding," Babcock says. Now she trains with Booli Selmayr, and rides Teddy, an Irish import. But not this weekend. Her commitments to the MHT will keep her out of the saddle and rooting for Booli.

SHARYN ANTICO: Trail Riding. Eventer. Eventing Official. Sharyn grew up on a small farm in Southwick, Mass. “My parents raised Quarter Horses,” she says. And she rode Western. But in college she started eventing and has been involved in the sport ever since. Sharyn competed up to preliminary level and took on jobs as secretary for various horse trials. But at some point, she asked herself, “Do I go to

competitions and earn money or go to competitions and spend money?” It was a real-world decision that has led her to a fairly substantial career wearing several different hats. She is the event manager for the Equestrian Center at Mount Holyoke College; the Executive Director for the American Horse Trials Foundation; and is often the Technical Delegate at events; but she has been loyal to the MHT team since 2006, acting as both secretary and show organizer. And that small farm in Southwick? She bought it from her parents and is raising her kids there and teaching them to ride.

Welcome to our Spectators

We hope that everyone will have a good time at the Millbrook Horse Trials. No other sport permits the spectator such an active role, but one person in the wrong place can ruin months and years of hard work for competitors, as well as place all parties in jeopardy of physical injury. To ensure your safety and that of the competitors, and to preserve the fairness of the competition, please familiarize yourself with the guidelines:



HORSES HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. The horses and riders will be moving at speed across country. Always look both ways before moving and stay alert for warnings from officials. Stay behind marked barriers and ropes and keep clear of the area around each cross-country fence. Please observe the advice or directions of fence judges on the cross-country course.

CHILDREN MUST BE WITH AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES. Children often do not realize the danger that horses present.

DOGS MUST BE LEASHED. Absolutely no exceptions! Loose dogs are a hazard to competing horses and will be impounded and the owners fined \$50. Noisy or disruptive dogs must be removed from the grounds.

AVOID UNAUTHORIZED ASSISTANCE TO COMPETITORS. Providing assistance to a rider during competition, whether solicited or not, is forbidden, under penalty of the competitor's elimination. The only exception to the no assistance rule is in the case of a fall. Officials or spectators may catch a loose horse or aid a fallen rider to remount and adjust saddlery. No one, however, may mount the horse except the rider.

QUIET, PLEASE! Undue noises can cause distractions to horses and riders and can affect the outcome of the competition or cause an accident. Please hold your applause until after a competitor exits the dressage arena, completes a cross-country fence, or finishes the stadium course.

Please be considerate of the site and use trash receptacles. Portions of the competition adjoin private property. We hope you will respect the land and privacy of these generous neighbors.

While observing these precautions, please feel free to move about the competition area in order to see as much as possible of the varied activities. Do not hesitate to ask questions of volunteers and officials, who will be happy to assist you.

The Three Horse Trials Disciplines

Millbrook Horse Trials is conducted under the auspices of the United States Eventing Association (USEA) and the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). In a Horse Trials, the rider and horse, competing at the division level appropriate to their experience, must participate in three different phases: Dressage, Cross Country, and Stadium Jumping. Penalty points from each of these phases are totaled for a final standing. The lowest score wins the division.

DRESSAGE

The dressage test is a series of compulsory movements performed on the flat in an arena. The performance must be fluid, balanced, and accurate, presenting an overall picture of grace and harmony. It reflects the cavalry officer's need for an obedient, attractive mount on the parade ground. Getting a calm, submissive, and well-balanced test from an extremely fit and eager horse before its strenuous gallop cross country is a real achievement.

Each movement of the dressage test is awarded from 0-10 good marks. The good marks earned (minus any error of course or test) are converted into a percentage of the maximum marks available. This percentage is subtracted from 100 to create the penalty score for the test. The resulting total is the score in penalty points for the test.

CROSS COUNTRY

In this phase, considered the most demanding and exciting part of a Horse Trials, the horse and rider must gallop over natural terrain, negotiating at speed a variety of unfamiliar jumping obstacles. The horse does not know what is ahead, but must trust and unhesitatingly obey the rider, who has studied the course beforehand. Water, banks, ditches, drops and other features of natural terrain may be encountered, as well as man-made obstructions. Options of height and striding (distance between jumping efforts) further challenge the competitor's skill and control.

Cross Country proves the speed, endurance and jumping ability of the horse as well as the boldness and knowledge of the rider. It is the most important part of the entire competition and counts most in scoring. Time penalties are assessed, as well as penalties for refusals and falls at jumps and deviations from course.

STADIUM JUMPING

Stadium Jumping tests the horse's obedience and athleticism over a timed course of fixtures which can be easily knocked down by a careless horse. The track of the course is irregular and winding, requiring control and handiness. Penalty points are assessed for knockdowns, refusals, falls, deviations from course, or for exceeding the time allowed. The object of the Stadium Jumping test is to prove that, after jumping solid obstacles at speed in the Cross Country, horses maintain the obedience to jump a course of obstacles cleanly at a controlled pace.

At the end of the Stadium Jumping, each completing competitor's scores from Dressage, Cross Country, and Stadium are totaled. The horse and rider team with the lowest number of penalties is declared the winner. The pageantry of the final ceremonies with trophies and awards is only a small part of the competitor's experience. The true rewards lie in the competition itself. Preparing for, meeting, and mastering the widely varied demands of combined training allow riders to discover what they and their mounts can do. Those who have completed the event can rightly pride themselves on their accomplishments.

Amateur certification under this provision is valid for Eventing competitions only and does not confer Amateur status for participation in any other Breed or Discipline.
